Prayers in the Yesodey Hatorah Senior Girls School are said together by the whole student body, twice daily:

Shacharis Morning Prayers start every morning at 8.22 am

Mincha Afternoon Prayers are said at 1.20 pm during winter and at
2.55 pm during summer

Extra prayers are said at designated times during the year, such as Rosh Chodesh (Head of the month); Chanuka; on Fast days etc.

All students are encouraged to follow their family traditions during prayers.

A student from Year 11 starts the prayers and the girls all continue individually and quietly. Great emphasis is put on deferential and respectful conduct at all times in the school hall during prayers.

The girls sit with their own class groups.

A member of staff is in attendance during prayers.
